Question 3 Doubling in Caterpillar Country (11 marks) -eme = present -eke = past

Second half of rem = from the 1st vowel onward →

3.1	eme = "is Xing" (present continuous) - eke = "was Xing" (imperfect)	1
3.2	To form the ("keeps on doing X") part of the verb if stem begins with vowel Stem + "ep" + stem + present ending ("eme") BUT if the stem is two syllables long or doesn't begin with a vowel stem + "ep" + ^{half} second syllable of stem + present ending ("eme")	3
3.3	To form ("starts to do X") ... Stem + "elp" + stem + "eme" But if the stem has 2 syllables ... 1 st ^{half} syllable of stem + "elp" + 1 st ^{half} syllable of stem + 2 nd ^{half} syllable of stem + "eme"	2 1/2
